About correspondence to new coronavirus infectious disease in municipal elementary and junior high school

We are currently informed that faculty members and students are infected in municipal elementary and junior high schools, so we will inform you about the correspondence of children (hereinafter referred to as "children") who attend elementary and junior high schools at home. **We have refrained from going to school if there is a symptom of a cold, such as a fever, in the same person as**

the child, and we will refrain from going to school . I will do it.

Also, in that case, attendance will be suspended instead of being absent.

About "temporary closing period" in 1 municipal elementary and junior high school

When children and faculty members are infected

(1) The school (including children's clubs after school)

will be available for approximately 2 days from the day after the infection was found.

*However, depending on the school attendance of the infected person, it may not be necessary to close the school.

Two weeks (14 days) from the day after the last school day of the affected class (including children's clubs after school)

About "suspension period" in 2 municipal elementary and junior high schools

(1)

The period until the child is infected and the specialist doctor, etc. acknowledges healing and is allowed to go to school.

(2) When the child is identified as a rich contact person The period instructed by the public health center

(3) When the cohabitant of the child is identified as a rich contact person The period from the day when the cohabitant is identified as a rich contact person to the day when the PCR test shows "negative"

3 Other

You will not be absent during the suspension period.

During the period when it is not possible to attend school, the school will endeavor to ensure the physical and mental safety and security of children, as well as guarantee their academic ability.

If you have any concerns, please feel free to contact each school.

Please check with your child's school or other kindergarten for information regarding child care.
