



## 1. Applications

- ◎ **Application period: May 25 (Mon.), 2020 – February 26 (Fri.), 2021 9:00 – 17:15**  
(Except weekends, national holidays, and year-end and New Year's holidays)

The amount of subsidy given will vary according to the time of application. (For details, see p.3.)  
Applications received May. 25 (Mon) – Aug. 24 (Mon)...Subsidies for 1<sup>st</sup>, 2<sup>nd</sup> and 3<sup>rd</sup> school terms  
Applications received Aug. 25(Tue) – Dec. 28(Mon)...Subsidies for 2<sup>nd</sup> and 3<sup>rd</sup> school terms  
Applications received Jan. 4(Mon) – Feb. 26(Fri)...Subsidy for 3<sup>rd</sup> school term only

- ◎ **Place: Please see p.1.**

- ◎ **Required Items:**

- ① **Bank account information of parent/guardian** (bank book)
- ② **Hanko (personal seal):** This does not have to be a registered seal, but self-inking automatic seals cannot be used.
- ③ Other documentation is also required, if you fit into one of the categories below.

## 2. Review of Income, etc.

- ◎ **Set Amount** (Your eligibility will be determined based on your income from Jan to Dec 2019)

**Eligibility requirements change from FY2020**

From this fiscal year, your eligibility will be reviewed based on the total income of all family members registered in the same household (shown on the resident record) as the student. Even if a parent (or a guardian) is registered at a different address for unaccompanied posting or other reasons, his/her income also will be added.

- \* Please refer your income amount to *Gensen-choshu-hyo* (the withholding tax statement) for 2019 or a copy of the final tax return.(See p.4)
- \* If you are in financial difficulties because of a disaster, including fire or losing your job, please consult us.
- \* If you face special circumstances such as ongoing negotiations on a settlement with your spouse, your applications may be reviewed as that of a single-parent family. Please consult us for more details.

## ◎ Declaration of Income

Your income will be confirmed by the Citizens Tax Division when your application is reviewed. Please be sure to complete your income declaration for 2019, otherwise we will not be able to check. When declaring your income, note the points below.

- If you have dependents, including spouse and children ... Fill in dependents' information
- If you are a widow or a widower in a single-parent family... Tick the designated box on the form
- Even if your income before tax was ¥650,000 or less and your taxable income was ¥0, please declare it

## 3. Results of Review

We will send results by mail.

- If you apply between May 25 and June 16... Results will be sent around the end of July
- If you apply after June 17 ... Results will be sent after July. (1 - 2 months after the application)

In case you have not declared your income or your application is incomplete, the result may not be sent by the end of July even if you make the application by June 16.

## 4. Payment

If your application is approved, we will pay the subsidies into the parent's/guardian's bank account in two installments. Do not close the account until the end of March, 2021. If you would like to change the account for payment of the subsidy, contact Gakumu Section.

※ If you apply after June 17, have not declared your income, or make an incomplete application, you may not be able to receive the subsidy on the payment days in August and February. In such cases, we will inform you of your payment dates in the notice of the results of review.

※1 This total amount is for those who are approved to receive the subsidy from the 1<sup>st</sup> term and stay eligible from April 2020 to March 2021 The amount will change if you move in/out of the city or start/stop receiving public assistance during the academic year.

※2 If you receive a subsidy for school supplies for starting school before your child starts elementary school or when he/she in the 6<sup>th</sup> grade, you will not receive it again in the 1<sup>st</sup> grade of elementary / junior high school even if you are approved for the school subsidy.

- ◎ **The expenses below will be added.**

<b>School lunch fee</b> Only for students attending Toyonaka municipal elementary/junior high schools	The amount already paid by parents/guardians * Recipients of the school subsidy need not pay school lunch fees from the next term of sending date of the review result. For details please refer to the information about school lunch fees enclosed with the result. If you receive a notice of approval at the end of July... <b>School lunch fees you have paid (elementary school: fees for April to June, junior high school: fees for April to July) will be added to the 1<sup>st</sup> payment. You need not pay school lunch fees for the 2<sup>nd</sup> (for elementary school children, the fee for July, too) and 3<sup>rd</sup> terms.</b> School lunch fees will not be added to the 2 <sup>nd</sup> payment.	
<b>School trip fee</b> Only for students who participate	Elementary School: actual cost up to 24,000 yen Junior High: actual cost up to 60,000 yen	* Added to the 1 <sup>st</sup> payment if the program is held in the 1 <sup>st</sup> term. * Added to the 2 <sup>nd</sup> payment if it is held in the 2 <sup>nd</sup> or 3 <sup>rd</sup> term
<b>School camp fee</b> Only for students who participate	Elementary School: actual cost up to 3,690 yen Junior High: actual cost up to 6,210 yen	* Depending on the situation such as the time of the program, payments may be made on a different day from the 1 <sup>st</sup> or 2 <sup>nd</sup> payment. In that case, we will send you a remittance notice. .

- \* Before paying the subsidy, we will check your payment record of school supplies/lunch fees as well as your child's participation in the school trip/camp.
- \* If you have not paid the fees for school supplies, a school trip or a school camp, we may make the payment directly to the principal. If you have not paid the fees for school lunches, we may make the payment directly to the Mayor of Toyonaka City.
