About phased reopening of educational activities in municipal Elementary and Junior high schools

Thank you for your always understanding and cooperation with the school education of Toyonaka City.

With the cancellation of the state of emergency, Osaka Prefecture has requested a response and Toyonaka City will resume educational activities in stage from June 1 (Mon.)

Please note that there will be emergency school closures until May 31(Sun.) and we will continue to implement with staggered attendance.

1. From June 1 (Mon.) to June 12 (Fri.)

Positioned as a “start-up period” for full-scale reopening, we will implement staggered attendance, and aim for a smooth transition to a “new school lifestyle” through school education activities such as classes and school lunches.

1. Staggered attendance

- In both Elementary and Junior high schools, all grade classes will be divided into two groups (about 20 students) and will implement staggered schedule every other day for each group.

2. School lunch

- Elementary schools will start school lunch on June 1 (Mon.) for 2nd grader and higher, and June 3 (Wed.) for 1st grader.
- Junior high schools will start school lunch (delivery method) from June 1 (Mon.).
- ✂For details of the implementation, please check with the website of Toyonaka City.

3. Classes

- Elementary schools will hold 4 hour-classes (till 4th period) for all graders until June 4 (Thurs.). After June 5 (Fri.), 1st to 3rd graders will have 5 hour-classes (till 5th period) and 4th to 6th graders will have 6 hour-classes (till 6th period).
- Junior high schools will hold 5 hour-classes (till 5th period) for all graders until June 4 (Thurs.). After June 5 (Fri.), all graders will have 6 hour-classes (till 6th period).
- ✂For details of the implementation, please check the school contact email or school website.

4. Note on attending school

- As always, take the temperature every day and check the health condition of your child. Also, when coming to school, wears a mask.
- If your child has a fever or other cold symptoms, inform the school and have a rest at home. Regarding attendance, he/she will not be treated as absent even if refraining from school attendance due to concern about infection. Be sure to contact the school for consultation.
- In order to prevent the spread of infection, if your child or your family member is infected with COVID-19, and if you are identified as a closed contact person, please inform the school immediately.

2. After June 15 (Mon.)

- After thoroughly implementing infection control measures, classes will be held according to the regular time table and the school will be fully restarted.

After June 1(Fri.), We (*Hokago Kodomo Club*) will provide the childcare service without limiting the target as before. For details, please check with the webpage of Toyonaka City.
