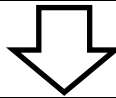
## Weather and Disaster Response

Before students come to school

### <Weather warnings>

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| Lifted before<br>10:00 am          | <b>Students come to school in groups</b><br>(We will announce the time for starting classes by the School Communication Email) | * If the warning is lifted before 10:00 am, school lunch will be provided.<br>Students will have classes as usual after the lift of the warning. |
| In effect at and<br>after 10:00 am | <b>Emergency school closure</b><br>(Hokago kodomo club will be cancelled, too.)  |  |

### <earthquakes>

If an **earthquake of seismic intensity 5 or above** occurs in Toyonaka City

**Emergency school closure**

\* Even if the seismic intensity is below 5, in case you feel it dangerous to send your child to school due to serious damages within the school district, have your child stand by at home.

(If a student does not come to school out of his/her parent's decision for his/her safety, the case will not be treated as absence but as suspension of attendance.)

#### How to get warning information

1. Website of Toyonaka City (Click "Warnings/Advisories in Toyonaka City")
2. Email delivered by "Osaka Bosai Net" (registration required)
3. Center for Providing Disaster Management Information of Ministry of Land, Infrastructure, Transport and Tourism (mobile phone site)
4. Shoji Elementary School Communication Email (see reverse for registration)

☆ Respond to the warnings based on the information announced through the School Communication Emails.

- Refrain from calling school to request information.
- Refrain from calling or contacting PTA board members, seikatsu shido board members and so on for information.
- Oame keiho – dosha saigai (heavy rain warning – landslide) is not subject to the weather and disaster response. If only oame keiho –dosha saigai is issued, we will not take the measure of "standing by at home" or "school closure" but provide classes as usual.

After students come to school

<weather warnings> **Principle: Keeping students at school** (for students' safety)

\* Considering the weather condition, damage in the school district and students' safety, we will take appropriate measures of either having students go home in groups, continuing to keep them at school, or other measures.



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| <p><b>Sending students home in groups</b></p> <p>We will announce the time of their leaving school by the School Communication Email.</p>        | <ul style="list-style-type: none"><li>• <b>Teachers will escort students to the students' pick-up place</b><br/>Teachers will make sure to hand over each student to a proper person. Come to the students' pick-up place to collect your child, if possible.<br/>(The pick-up place is decided for each area.)</li><li>* <u>If your child cannot enter your house</u>, we will take him/her back to school. (Classroom teacher will contact the parents. In that case, come to collect your child as soon as possible.)</li></ul> | <p>We will treat the <u>students attending the Hokago Kodomo Club</u> according to the "Emergency Response Manual for Hokago Kodomo Club Students."</p> |
| <p><b>Continue to keep students</b></p> <p>We will announce the time for picking up students by each grade by the school communication email</p> | <ul style="list-style-type: none"><li>• <b>Principle: Handing over students to parents</b><br/>Come to collect your child to each classroom without changing into indoor shoes.<br/>We will hand over students after <u>identifying the person by the "Student Pick-up Card"</u>.<br/>We will keep students at school until a proper person comes to collect them.</li></ul>   | <p>We will treat the <u>students attending the Hokago Kodomo Club</u> according to the "Emergency Response Manual for Hokago Kodomo Club Students."</p> |

\* If you are not at home while your child is at school, discuss emergency response with your child and confirm whether he/she should stay at school or go home with other students on a day a weather warning is expected.

<Earthquake> If an earthquake of seismic intensity 5 or above occurs in Toyonaka, **we will keep students at school** (to secure their safety).

\* Even if the seismic intensity is below 5, we will keep students at school in case we feel there is a danger.

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| <p><b>Keeping students at school</b></p> | <ul style="list-style-type: none"><li>• <b>Principle: Handing over students to parents</b><br/><b>Come to the waiting place to collect your child.</b><br/>(We will announce where the waiting place is by the School Communication Email. Waiting place will be either each classroom, school ground, or gymnasium.)<br/>We will hand over students <u>after identifying the person by the "Student pick-up Card"</u>. We will keep students at school until a proper person comes to collect them.</li></ul> | <p>We will treat the <u>students attending the Hokago Kodomo Club</u> according to the "Emergency Response Manual for Hokago Kodomo Club Students".</p> |
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\* If we can send a School Communication Email: We will announce that we are keeping students at school.

\* If we cannot send a School Communication Email: We will keep students at school.

\* If you are not at home while your child is at school, discuss emergency response with your child and decide how to contact and where to meet each other.

☆ If an evacuation place is set up, we will take over the response to the person in charge of the evacuation place.
